The Board of JMP Consultants Limited recognises the importance of quality and has drawn up this Quality Policy which is promoted and controlled through our Integrated Management System (IMS).


The IMS consists of interactive processes which together aim to show consistency in service provision and achieve the requirements of our Clients.
